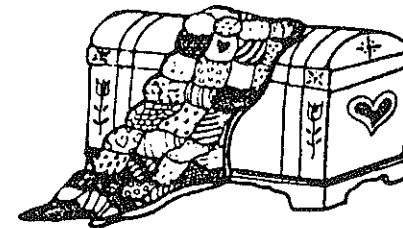

Working with Stripes - Jane has been quilting for 35 years. She initiated and taught the art of quilting at the Old Bethpage Village Restoration here on LI. She also was invited and took part in "The Celebrate America" Program at the Museum of American Folk Art in New York City.

2:30 p.m. LORETTA KRIEGER

Antique and Old Quilts - Loretta's mother taught her how to quilt at the age of 9 years. She made her first complete quilt at the age of 15. She is one of the original founders of LI Quilters and was their President for 3-1/2 years. She has been restoring quilts since the 1940's with her mother. She presently teaches, lectures and makes custom quilts. She has received many awards and has been written up in newspaper and magazine articles.
